Resolution Authorizing the Execution of “Fair and Open” Professional Services Contracts with the Borough of Bradley Beach for the Provision of Professional Services

Mayor Engelstad offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, there exists a need for professional services,,: Municipal Attorney, Municipal Engineer, Municipal Auditor, Labor Attorney, Prosecutor and Bond Council for the year January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2017.

WHEREAS the borough has, through the fair and open process, advertised on its website the solicitation for receipt of proposals from legal firms for said services and two proposals from legal services: five proposals for Engineer, ten proposals for Labor Attorney, seven proposals for Bond Counsel, nine proposals for Municipal Attorney, three proposals for Prosecutor and two proposals for Auditor were received and documented on Thursday, December 1, 2016: and

WHEREAS, the borough has reviewed all proposals received and has determined that the Borough Council desires to authorize the execution of a professional services contract between following listed persons/firms and the borough for the provisions of said services for the year 2017: and

WHEREAS, the listed persons/firms acknowledge and certify they have not made any political contributions that would bar them from being awarded a contract with the Borough of Bradley Beach
