

Bradley Beach Volunteer Programs

The following are current Bradley Beach Volunteer Programs and descriptions.

1. Arts Council
Design and deliver arts programs to a Bradley Beach, engaging volunteers for promotion, production, sets, acting, event logistics.
2. Emergency Management
Support Bradley Beach during emergencies with volunteers who assist in delivering information and services to residents and business owners.
3. Fire Department (Administration, Firefighters)
First responders to fires, with volunteers serving as drivers, emergency medical responders, interior firefighters, exterior firefighters, and support personnel. Training provided for certification as New Jersey certified firefighters.
4. First Aid Squad (Administration, First Aid Responders)
First responders, serving as volunteer emergency medical technicians and support personnel. Training provided.
5. Food Pantry (501c3)
The Bradley Beach Food Pantry provides bags of groceries to families in need, Monday – Friday from 10am to noon and Thursday evenings from 6-7pm. Volunteers are needed to assist during these hours.
6. Library
Friends of the Library (501c3)
Volunteers enhance the artistic, cultural, humanitarian, intellectual and literary aspects of our community through fundraising to support the Library

Volunteers help with activities throughout the library including organizing library materials and working with library staff to prep for programs for library users of all ages.

7. Green Team (Environmental Commission)

Volunteers for cleanup events at beach, lakes and town areas.

8. Historical Society (501c3)

Bradley Beach Historical Mission is to collect and preserve local historical data and artifacts for the education and enjoyment of present and future generations. Members/volunteers serve as docents for our museum, catalogue archives, collect oral histories, provide research, act as event designers/coordinators, and display preparers, support sales and merchandising and promote Historical Society on social media.

9. Ladies Auxiliary

Volunteers support the Bradley Beach Fire Company through fundraising and assisting in the event of a fire emergency by serving water, *coffee* and food .

10. Memorial Day/Labor Day Committee

Volunteers assist in the planning and organizing of the Memorial Day parade as well as the Memorial Day/Labor Day events on the boardwalk, including the oversight of proceeds which are selected for Borough of Bradley Beach.

11. Recreation Department

Volunteers support youth after school and sports programs, one day Saturday events and Recreation Center beautification projects.

12. Senior Center

Seniors participate and volunteer to support activities at the Senior Center.
