COUNCIL COMMENTS

John Weber thanked his family and the council members for their support. He commented on how great the meeting/courtroom looks and thanked the DPW. Councilman Cotler thanked his wife for allowing him to serve on Council. He requested a moment of silence for victims and families of people affected by violence this past year. He continued that he would strive to continue to do good work for Bradley Beach and to always listen to complaints and suggestions from residents. He wished everyone a Happy and Healthy New Year.

Mayor Engelstad stated that when he sat on this dais four years ago we were reeling from Superstorm Sandy. Now Bradley Beach has never looked better. We are a desirable town, a place many people wish to visit. I am pleased to announce that the Municipal Court is back in Bradley Beach and with a shared service agreement with Avon Court. The bids for trash/recycling collection came in with a significant increase, and the Public Works Department is taking on the task of trash collection. He thanked all of the borough employees who worked together this past week in reference to the in house trash collection. He continued to thank the elected officials and stated he was looking forward to working with all of them. He then thanked his wife, family and extended family for their constant support.

PUBLIC COMMENT

John Zech, stated as Chief of Fire Department and Captain of the First Aid he wanted to thank the ladies in the front office for their assistance this past year. He continued by thanking the Mayor and Council for support and all of the volunteers in the Fire and First Aid Department.
