ORDINANCE 2020-17

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE I ATTENDANT TO BOROUGH CODE SECTION 9.3.3 AND SCHEDULE II ATTENDANT TO BOROUGH CODE SECTION 9.3.4 OF CHAPTER 9: “TRAFFIC” TO CREATE NO PARKING ZONES ON NEWARK AVENUE TO ENHANCE TRAFFIC SAFETY DURING GARBAGE COLLECTION

Mayor Engelstad offered the following Ordinance and moved its introduction:

WHEREAS, the Borough DPW Director has brought to the Mayor & Council’s attention potential public safety hazards during garbage collection on Newark Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find it to be in the best interests of the Borough’s residents to create certain no parking zones on Newark Avenue to remediate the safety issues brought to their attention;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bradley Beach, County of Monmouth, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. “Schedule I” attendant to Section 9-3.3 entitled “Parking Prohibited At All Times On Certain Streets” of Chapter 9: “Traffic” of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Bradley Beach is hereby amended to include the following additional entries in the listing of locations therein:

Name of Street	Side	Location
Newark Avenue	Northerly	Beginning at a point of 154 feet west from the westerly curblineline of Central Avenue and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 7 feet.

SECTION 2. “Schedule II” attendant to Section 9-3.4 entitled “Parking Prohibited At All Times On Certain Streets” of Chapter 9: “Traffic” of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Bradley Beach is hereby amended to include the following additional entries in the listing of locations therein:

Name of Street	Side	Hours/Days	Location
Newark Avenue	Southerly	7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. Tuesday and Friday	Beginning at a point of 18 feet from the easterly curblineline of Madison Avenue and extending in an easterly direction for distance of 42 feet.
Newark Avenue	Southerly	7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. Tuesday and Friday	Beginning at a point of 157 feet west from the westerly curblineline of Central Avenue and extending in an westerly direction for distance of 22 feet.

SECTION 3. If any article, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance and they shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. In the event of any inconsistencies between the provisions of this Ordinance and any prior ordinance of the Borough, the provisions hereof shall be determined to govern. All other parts, portions and provisions of The Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Bradley Beach are hereby ratified and confirmed, except where inconsistent with the terms hereof.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and publication in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
