

**ORDINANCE 2017-20**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF BRADLEY BEACH, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER 123, BEACHFRONT AREAS AND ADJACENT WATERS, ARTICLE 8, AMENDING SECTION Z

123-8 Rules and Regulations

- Z. Tents or Canopies. No person shall bring, erect or install a tent or canopy on the beaches. Only traditional umbrellas are permitted on the beaches; as defined: collapsible shade for protection against weather consisting of fabric stretched over hinged ribs radiating from a central pole. (Especially a small one for carry in hand)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bradley Beach that Chapter One Hundred Twenty Three, Article 8, Section Z, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Bradley Beach shall be amended to reflect said change.

This ordinance shall take effect on its final passage and publication according as provided by law.
