

**ORDINANCE 2019-11**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bradley Beach (“Borough”) has adopted Chapter 123, to regulate THE Beachfront Areas and Adjacent Waters, within the Borough; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bradley Beach, Monmouth County, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 123 of the Borough Code be amended as follows:

**Chapter 123**

**BEACHFRONT AREAS AND ADJACENT WATERS**

**123-8. Rules and regulations.**

E. **Disposal of litter.**<sup>1</sup> No person shall discard ~~bottles, cans, paper or other~~ refuse, including but not limited to cigarette butts, cigar butts, and other tobacco products, in the beachfront area. Bottles, cans, newspaper, clean paper and other recyclable materials shall be placed in marked recyclable containers provided by the municipality. All refuse, paper and litter shall be placed in refuse containers provided by the municipality. The maximum penalty for violating this regulation is set forth in Chapter 1, Article II, General Penalty, of the Borough Code. The minimum penalty is \$100 and two days' community service.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the Courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall only apply to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after passage by the Mayor and Council and publication according to law.

**SO ORDAINED** as aforesaid.
