

ORDINANCE 2019-7

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF BRADLEY BEACH, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER ONE HUNDRED TWENTY THREE, BEACHFRONT AREAS AND ADJACENT WATERS, RULES AND REGULATIONS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bradley Beach, Monmouth County, State of New Jersey, that Chapter 123, Beachfront Area and Adjacent Waters, Rules and Regulations of the Borough of Bradley Beach code be amended and supplemented as follows:

123-8 **Z.**

Tents or canopies. No person shall bring, erect or install a tent or canopy on the beaches. Only baby tents no larger than 36 inches high by 36 inches wide by 36 inches deep utilized for infants and small children and traditional umbrellas are permitted on the beaches; as defined: collapsible shade for protection against weather, consisting of fabric stretched over hinged ribs radiating from a central pole (especially a small one for carrying in hand).

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the Courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall only apply to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after passage by the Mayor and Council and publication according to law.
