

ORDINANCE 2019-9

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF BRADLEY BEACH, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, CHAPTER 123, MUNICIPAL PUBLIC ACCESS SIGNS

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection requires all communities that contain tidal waters to provide for public access; and

WHEREAS, existing and future signage for public access is required at all public access locations identified in the Municipal Public Access Plan; and

WHEREAS, installation and maintenance of signage is a requirement of N.J.A.C. 7:7E-8.11(t).

ARTICLE III

123-16 Municipal Public Access Signs

B. "Public Access Sign" shall be a posted sign depicting the public access point to, from and along tidal waterways and their shores within the Borough of Bradley Beach. Public access signs shall list the name of the access point as well as any restrictions.

(1) Location

All public access signs shall be installed at the entrance of the designated beach access points as outlined in the Municipal Public Access Plan.

(2) Schedule

All public access signs shall be installed annually by the Department of Public Works on April 15th and removed on October 15th.

(3) Maintenance

All public access signs shall be maintained by the Department of Public Works.

(4) Funding

The Borough of Bradley Beach shall be responsible for the cost of all public access signs.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that if any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by the Courts to be invalid, such adjudication shall only apply to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause or provision so adjudicated, and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after passage by the Mayor and Council and publication according to law.

SO ORDAINED as aforesaid.
