RESOLUTION NO. 2014-

AUTHORIZES THE MAYOR OF BRADLEY BEACH TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE MONMOUTH COUNTY MOSQUITO EXTERMINATION COMMISSION

Mayor Engelstad offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Monmouth County Mosquito Extermination Commission has requested authorization to resume aerial surveillance and to apply pesticides from aircraft to control mosquito over portions of the Borough of Bradley Beach on or about April 1, 2014 and continuing through November 30, 2014; and

WHEREAS, it is further understood that the areas being treated are only those found to have a significantly high mosquito population and may present either a public health nuisance or disease factor; and

WHEREAS, this approval is subject to the Monmouth County Mosquito Extermination Commission notifying the local Bradley Beach Police Department prior to each and every application.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute a Memorandum of Agreement with the Monmouth County Mosquito Extermination Commission.
