INSTALLMENT PAYMENT PLAN
(To be approved by Mayor and Council)

I, JAMES SYMONS, do hereby agree to an installment payment plan which would allow me to pay property taxes (\$6,064.13) plus penalty for 1st thru 4th quarters, 2014, on property located at 601 Fifth Avenue, Block 57, Lot 14.
