**Resolution of Support from Bradley Beach Authorizing the  
Hurricane Sandy Coastal Resiliency Competitive Grants Program Application**

Mayor Engelstad offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, a coastal community seeks to promote community resiliency and reduce flood and storm risk for its residents by applying various nature-based and physical techniques to Fletcher and Sylvan Lakes; and

**WHEREAS**, Bradley Beach strives to save tax dollars, assure clean land, air and water, improve working and living environments; and

**WHEREAS**, one of the purposes of the Hurricane Sandy Coastal Resiliency Competitive Grants Program is to provide funding sources to rebuild, restore, and research natural defenses that protect communities; and

**WHEREAS**, Bradley Beach would use said funding source to assess, restore, enhance or create natural and manmade systems associated with their coastal lakes to better protect the community as well as fish and wildlife species and habitats from the impacts of future storms;
