RESOLUTION 2019-

Mayor Engelstad offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bradley Beach (“Borough”) solicited proposals under the competitive contracting process set forth in N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4.1 for the Renovation and Lease of the Retired Utility Building at Ocean and Park Place Avenue(s) (“Bid Solicitation”); and

WHEREAS, proposals were received from TM Foods and John Grillo on July 31, 2019 for Bid Solicitation; and

WHEREAS, the Borough issued a Notification of Amended Bid Specifications for the Bid Solicitation with an amended, proposal submission deadline of August 21, 2019; and

WHEREAS, an amended proposal was received only from TM Foods on August 21, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Borough reserved the right to reject one or all proposals at any time prior to executing a formal Lease, for any or no reason, without penalty or liability, and is exercising that right; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council hereby reject the proposals received from TM Foods and John Grillo on July 31, 2019, and the amended, proposal received from TM Foods on August 21, 2019, and hereby authorize the Borough Clerk to re-issue this Bid Solicitation, subject to the review of the Bid Specifications by the Qualified Purchasing Agent, Borough Counsel and Borough Engineer, as soon as possible.
