RESOLUTION NO. 2019-

Mayor Engelstad offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, a senior citizen who filed for the allowance of \$250 per year, deducted from their property tax bill, must file an Annual Post Tax Year Statement (PD5) with the Tax Collector by March 1, of the subsequent year. This statement is for the purpose of verifying income and residency for the deduction; and

WHEREAS, senior citizen deductions are disallowed for exceeding the income limitation or removed based upon the findings of the Post Tax Year Statement and the \$250 deduction is subsequently charged back to the property owner;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the owners of the following properties be disallowed as listed:
