

Bradley Beach Board of Recreation
Minutes of Meeting Held
Monday, February 27, 2012

I. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 7:06 pm by Jennifer Young, Meeting Facilitator.

II. PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Ms. Young.

III. ROLL CALL

The following members were in attendance: Jennifer Young, Heather Minsky, Michael Roth, Shawn Ryan and Barbara Carlucci. Cynthia Brady, Recreation Director was in attendance.

IV. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the meeting held January 23, 2012 were reviewed.

***MOTION:** by Heather Minsky, second by Michael Roth to approve the minutes as written. All in favor, motion carried, 5-0-0.*

It was discussed how there was not a quorum in November and therefore, no meeting minutes. Additionally, there was not a meeting in December.

V. RECREATION DIRECTOR'S REPORT

A written report was provided by Cynthia Brady. The following was discussed:

- 1. Yogalates:** Bethanne Tinkler was in attendance to discuss payment to the Rec Center. Ms. Tinkler's program was a Rec sponsored event. Originally, Yogalates was done in the Rec Center. It was advertised by the Rec Center. When summer came, Ms. Tinkler brought Yogalates to the beach. She continued to pay the Rec. Other people seemed to be teaching Yoga classes at the beach. These individuals did not have approval or recognition from the Rec Dept. Ms. Tinkler stopped making payments as previously agreed upon. At this time, she asked Julie Shreck, Mayor, if there was an ordinance that governed activities on the beachfront. At \$12 per class as her website advertises, it would come to \$400 that was owed.

Bethanne offered to pay \$240 in good faith and forget about the past fees since it was a grey area. The Recreation Committee discussed this issue and feels that it is a town issue.

It was discussed how more should be done to promote the program through the Rec Committee and the town. It was discussed how Yoga could be done with elderly, in a chair and a program could be developed for children.. Cynthia said

she would work on a flyer. It was discussed how a Recreation Calendar should be mailed to all residents. Further, there was a discrepancy in the amount charged for Yogalates with the town website (\$10/\$12).

There will be a fee if it is a Rec Committee endorsed program. If the program is not in the facility, there will be no facility charge.

For 8 people the fee is \$20.00

For less than 8 people, the fee is \$15.00

The Board will consider what policy should be. There should be a nominal fee if the activity is endorsed.

***MOTION:** by Heather Minsky, second by Shawn Ryan to charge a \$10.00 fee if the activity is off-site and a \$20.00 fee for activities endorsed by the Recreation Committee. Motion carried 5-0-0.*

2. **New Bleachers:** Cynthia advised that new bleachers were needed. Richie Bianchi, Operating Supervisor for Public Works was taking care of this.
3. **Monmouth County Park System RAP:** We have been a part of the Recreation Assistance Program for the past two years. This is a great program and it allows access to their services at greatly reduced price. This year, there is a \$25.00 fee to join. The Board voted to approve of this fee.

***MOTION:** by Heather Minsky, second by Jennifer Young to approve of the \$25.00 fee. Motion carried 5-0-0.*

4. **NCBLL:** It was discussed how every year, Bradley Beach pays Neptune City/Bradley Beach \$500.00. This year, new bases need to be purchased. A vote on this was tabled to confirm the amount charged.
5. **Sailing/Surfing/Summer:** It was discussed that the surfing program will be August 13 through August 24th. The ages are 8 – 16.

There will be 30 kids allowed in the surf program at no additional cost through the agreed upon scholarships. There will be 3 groups of ten.

June 25th is when camp starts as well as surf camp.

Bill Maxcy wants a raise. There is 2 weeks of planning before the season and he is paid \$500.00. Bill wants to redistribute this and only plan for 1 week. Bill has not had a raise in over 3 years. He is Mike Roth to pay Bill Maxcy \$563.00. All in favor, motion carried 5-0-0. Cynthia will advise the Recreation Committee recommends a raise for Bill Maxcy to \$563.00 for the summer. It is a 5 ½ hour day from 8:30 – 2:00.

6. Camp Fee – At the next meeting, the Committee will discuss raising the fee for camp from \$400.00 to \$550.00.
7. Tennis – Barbara Carlucci spoke to Ed who runs the tennis program in Ocean Grove. He and his son offer private lessons. We can participate in the Ocean Grove program.

We can use their facility and maybe eventually grow to use the court in Bradley. Ed was also interested in using the school for cross-training in the winter. Barb will ask if he can put something together.
