DESIGNATING A PUBLIC AGENCY COMPLIANCE OFFICER (P.A.C.O.)

Mayor Fox offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-3.2 et. seq., each public agency shall annually designate an officer or employee to serve as its Public Agency Compliance Officer (P.A.C.O);

WHEREAS, the individual designated as the Public Agency Compliance Officer will be the point of contact for all matters concerning implementation and administration of the legal requirements of the Equal Employment Opportunity Monitoring Program; and

WHEREAS, the Public Agency Compliance Officer is also responsible for administering contracting procedures pertaining to equal employment regarding both the public agency and its service providers;

WHEREAS, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 17:27-3.3, each public agency shall notify the State of New Jersey, Department of the Treasury, Division of Purchase & Property, Contract Compliance Audit Unit, EEO Monitoring Program of its designation by January 10th of each year;

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to designate Michele Whille, Deputy Clerk, to serve as its Public Agency Compliance Officer for the calendar year 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Governing Body of the Borough of Bradley Beach that Michele Whille, Deputy Clerk hereby designated to serve as its Public Agency Compliance Officer for the calendar year 2022.
