Shana Greenblatt applied for and we received a NJUCF \$15,000 Stewardship Grant for a town-wide inventory of trees

We reviewed 39 applications for tree removal or planting

We enrolled the graduating class of our grammar school to have an art contest, with Arbor day as its theme. Residents voted via social media

On April 24th- Bradley Beach has its "Green Fair". The commission helped organize it and had a table and a display of the school tree drawing.

On Arbor day, April 30th, we planted a Swamp White Oak in the park. This was dedicated to the graduating class, who attended and read a poem about trees. The winners of the art contest were announced, three prizes were given

We created the HONOR ME program- Residents pay for a planting strip tree to be planted in memory of a person or event. We planted 12 HONOR ME trees, 9 in planting strips

We created the WISHING TREE PROGRAM- Residents sign up for a free planting strip tree, when available. We planted 9 WISHING TREES in planting strips

We donated all 11 trees to the Second Avenue Park Extension. 3 were HONOR ME trees.

We replaced the dead dedication tree to Mrs. Napoli by the Firehouse

We planted a total of 29 trees in town

We began 'Tree of the Month'. Every month a tree and its homeowner are highlighted on social media and the local papers
