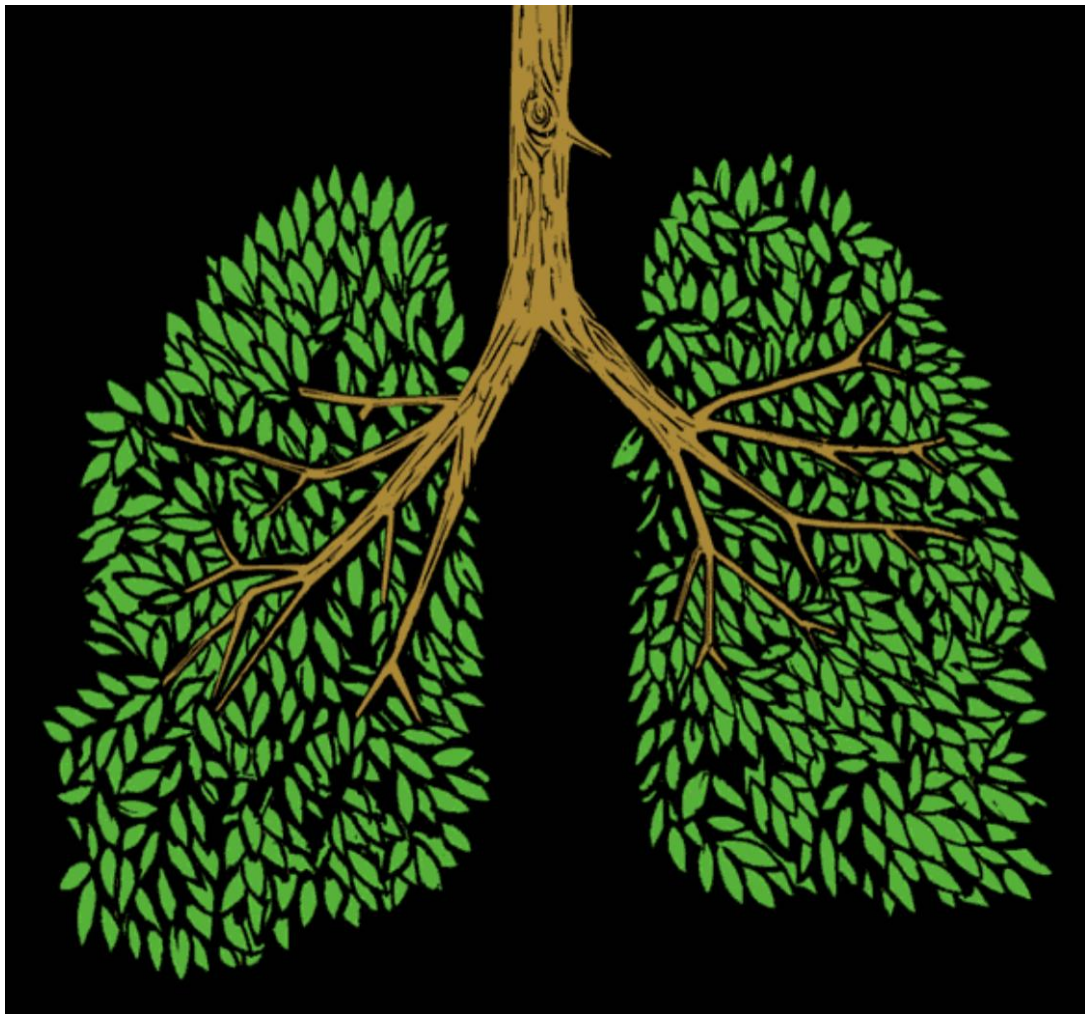




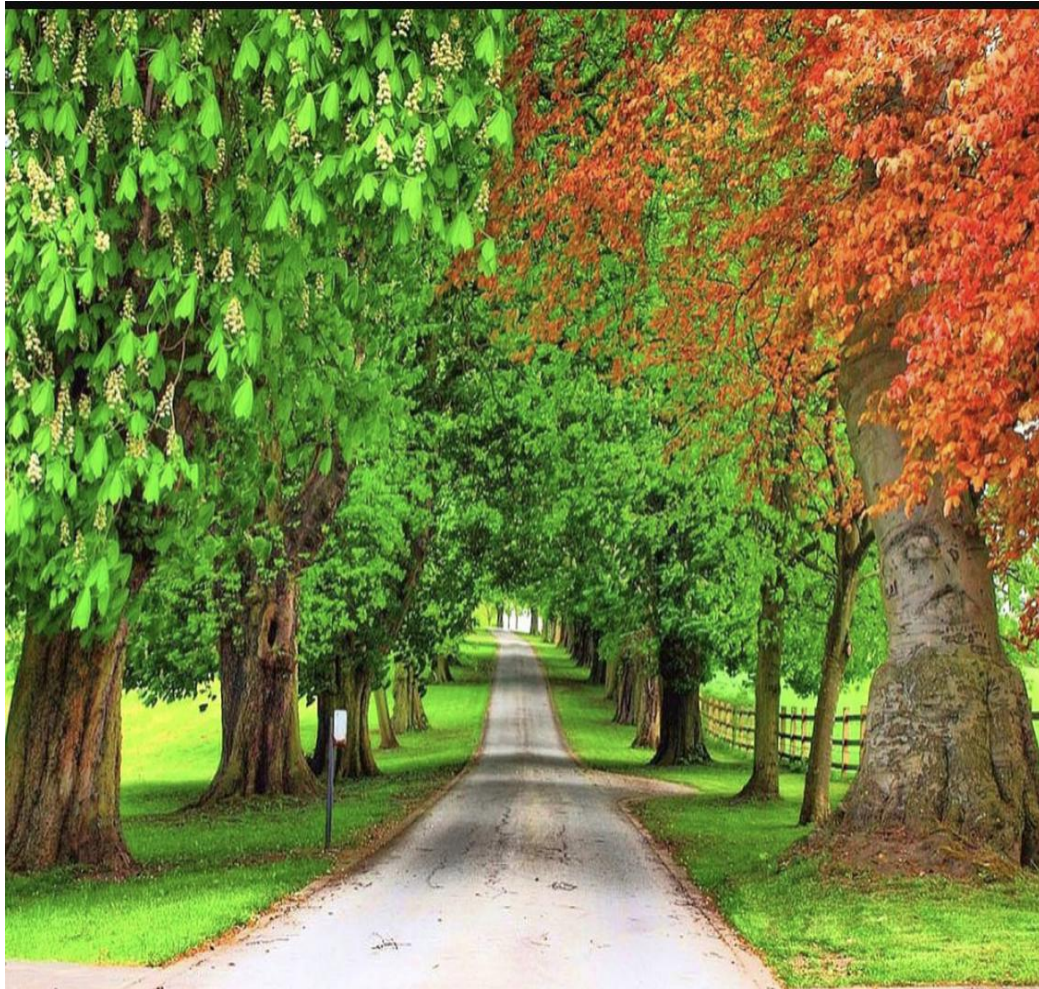
Why Trees Are Important

Trees can either store harmful pollutants or actually change the pollutant into less harmful forms.





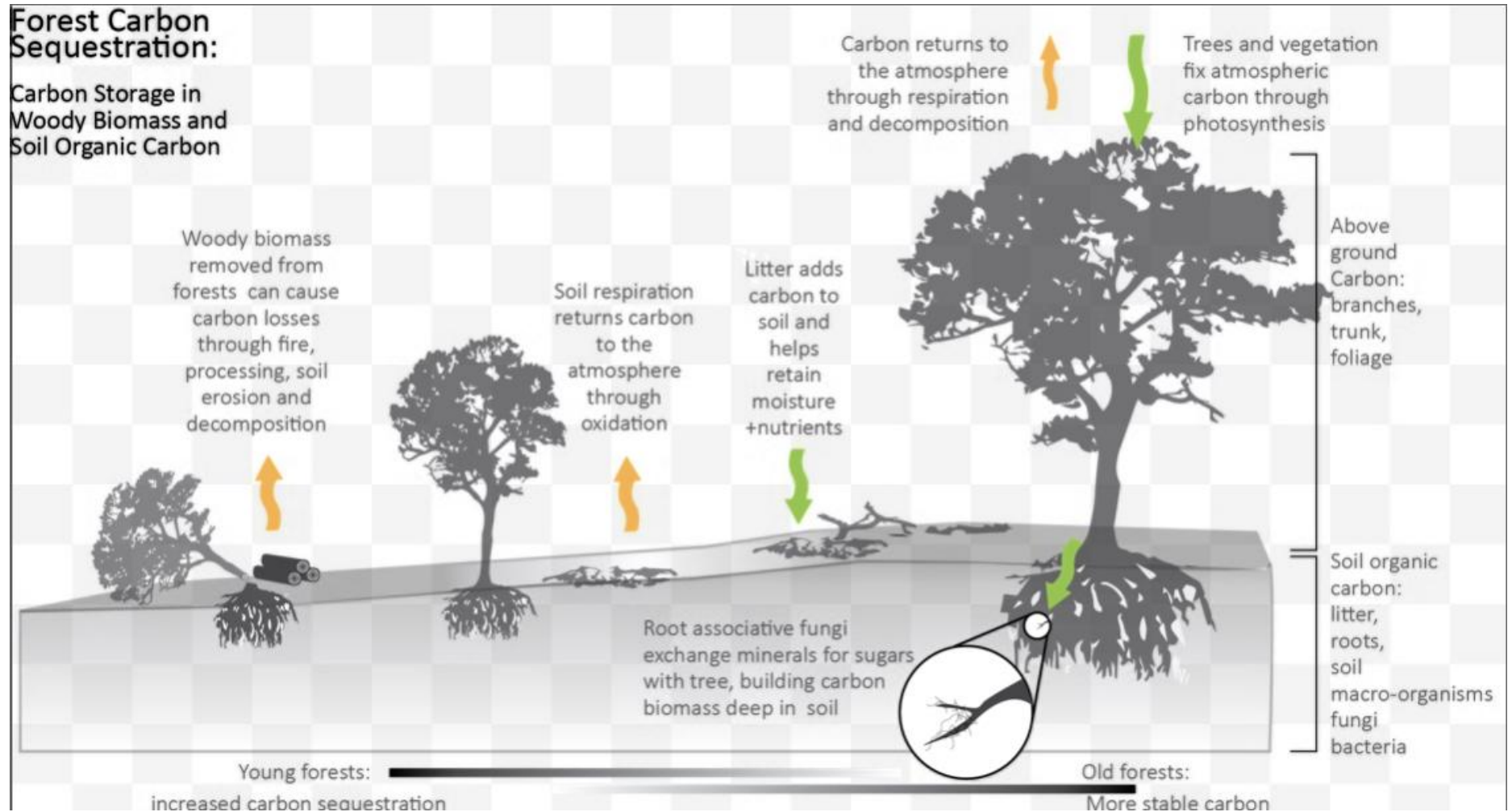
