Here is the size of leaf coverage in Bradley Beach at 67.3 acres, With a total of 403 acres of land in BB, leaf coverage is low at 16.7%. I think you should be looking to increase canopy by 100% if that can be done when discounting Ocean Avenue and much of the first block due to view obstructions and salt spray impacts.-

American Forests recommends a canopy coverage of around 40% but that number should not be taken as gospel in a beach community.
