**RESOLUTION APPROVING A FAIR AND OPEN PROFESSIONAL SERVICES
CONTRACT WITH PLOSLIA & COHEN, P.C. AS ALTERNATE LABOR ATTORNEY**

Mayor Gubitosi offered the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bradley Beach (the “Borough”), requires the services of an Alternate Labor Attorney; and

WHEREAS, after a fair-and-open process that advertised a request for proposals for professional services to fulfill said vacant position for the calendar year 2025, on January 1, 2025, the Borough duly appointed Plosia & Cohen, P.C. as Alternate Labor Attorney; and

WHEREAS, upon their appointment, Plosia & Cohen, P.C. provided the Borough with a Proposal for their professional services in the amount of \$175.00 per hour; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has issued a Certificate of Available Funds which is incorporated herein by reference;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bradley Beach, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that:

1. The Mayor and/or Administrator are authorized to enter into a professional services contract with Plosia & Cohen, P.C. to serve as Alternate Labor Attorney pursuant to the terms of the Proposal.
2. The engagement of Plosia & Cohen, P.C. is exempt from public bidding as a professional service under N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5.1(a)(i), and is being awarded under a “fair and open” process in accordance with New Jersey’ Pay-to-Play Law.
3. Notice of this Resolution shall be published in the designated official newspapers as required by law within ten (10) days of the passage of this Resolution.
4. A certified copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Borough Administrator, Borough CFO, and Plosia & Cohen, P.C.
