**WHEREAS** the Borough sought bids in accordance with in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-4a; and

**WHEREAS** the procurement was conducted in a fair and open manner in accordance with N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5; and

**WHEREAS** the Borough received three (3) bids:
