**RESOLUTION RATIFYING REVISION OF D'ARCY'S TAVERN SPECIAL EVENT PERMIT FROM SUNDAY, MARCH 1, 2026 TO SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 28, 2026 DUE TO WEATHER CONDITIONS BEYOND THE CONTROL OF THE APPLICANT**

**Councilwoman Greenblatt** offered the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Bradley Beach (the "Borough") received an application for a Special Events Permit from D'Arcy's Tavern pursuant to Borough Code Chapter 393; and

**WHEREAS**, D'Arcy's Tavern proposed to host a live band and serve outdoor food and beverage in its parking lot on Sunday, March 1, 2026 for the local Saint Patrick's Day Parade; and

**WHEREAS**, said application was approved by the Borough via Resolution 2026-71; and

**WHEREAS**, thereafter, the Special Event was required to change its intended date from Sunday, March 1, 2026 to Saturday, February 28, 2026 due to weather conditions beyond the control of the applicant; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough provided administrative approval for the aforesaid revision;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor & Council of the Borough of Bradley Beach, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, hereby ratify the Borough's administrative approval of the Special Event, as follows:

**D'Arcy's Tavern St. Patrick's Day Celebration**

**Saturday, February 28, 2026 from 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.**

**Outdoor Service of Food and Beverage, and live band in the parking lot.**

**Off-Duty Police Services at \$93.00/Hour, plus \$25.00/Hour Administrative Fee.**
