RESOLUTION 2020-132

RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2020-44 TO INCREASE THE COST OF 2020 DAILY BEACH BADGES TO OFFSET UNEXPECTED COVID-19 EXPENSES

Mayor Engelstad offered the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2020-44, dated January 28, 2020, the Mayor & Council of the Borough of Bradley Beach (the “Borough”), established the cost of daily beach badges for summer 2020 as \$10.00; and

WHEREAS, since the approval of Resolution No. 2020-44 on January 28, 2020, the COVID-19 crisis has required that the Borough incur additional costs to ensure the safety of residents and visitors enjoying its beach; and

WHEREAS, since the approval of Resolution No. 2020-44 on January 28, 2020, the COVID-19 crisis has required that the Borough limit the capacity of its beach, thereby further exacerbating the financial issues facing the Borough with its prior daily beach badge pricing; and

WHEREAS, the Borough finds it necessary to increase the cost of daily beach badges for summer 2020 from \$10.00 to \$13.00 for the aforementioned reasons;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor & the Council of the Borough of Bradley Beach hereby establish the fee for 2020 Daily Beach Badges as \$13.00 for persons thirteen (13) years of age and older.
