NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that a curfew be put into effect commencing with **October 30, 2021 through November 1, 2021**, that no person seventeen years of age and under shall be allowed on any of the streets of the Borough of Bradley Beach unless accompanied by a parent or guardian between the hours of **8:00 p.m. to 6:30 a.m.**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that within the resolution be deemed an action of the Mayor and Council.
