ANIMAL CONTROL SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH ASSOCIATED HUMANE SOCIETY FOR 2022

WHEREAS, the Associated Humane Societies, Inc., a non-profit charitable organization has provided the only proposal to provide said services and

WHEREAS, the Associated Humane Societies, Inc, has provided an agreement to provide said services at an appropriate fee.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement for Animal Control Services with the Associated Humane Societies for a period of one (1) year beginning January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022. The contract amount of \$13,000 for 2022 said sum to be prorated on a monthly basis of \$1083.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy be forwarded to the Business Administrator and the Chief Financial Officer.
