**AUTHORIZING A WINDOW CONTRACT FOR
PURCHASE OF SANITATION TRUCK**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq., when the cost of goods and/or services are under the Borough's bid threshold but exceed \$17,500.00 a resolution to approve that the contract is compliant with the New Jersey Local Unit Pay To Play Laws; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bradley Beach Sanitation Department need to replace a Sanitation truck; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Agent did receive quotes for this equipment and recommends the following company: Atlantic Sales and Salvage for 41,900.00 to be the most advantageous quote for cost and service; and

WHEREAS, the above named business or businesses have completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies the business entity has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the Borough of Bradley Beach in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit the above named vendors from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Borough of Bradley Beach authorizes the Purchasing Agent on behalf of the Borough to issue and execute a Purchase Order for the foregoing, with funds certified available by the Chief Financial Officer utilizing Capital Account C-01-82-928-000-093 – Ordinance 2018-23; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Business Administrator is hereby authorized to arrange to pay for the foregoing in accordance with the terms of the purchase order.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Business Disclosure Entity Certification be on file with this resolution and will be published in accordance with the Applicable law.

Purpose of Form


