RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH LEON S. AVAKIAN, INC. FOR THE 2020 NJDOT MUNICIPAL AID PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS TO NEWARK AVENUE PHASE II

Mayor Fox offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bradley Beach has a need to acquire professional services relative to engineering services required for the 2020 NJDOT Municipal Aid Project Improvements to Newark Avenue Phase II; and

WHEREAS, Leon S. Avakian, Inc. submitted a proposal dated January 5, 2021, to provide engineering services relative to the 2020 NJDOT Municipal Aid Project Improvements to Newark Avenue Phase II; and

WHEREAS, said proposal consisted of the following services and costs:

Phase I:	Preparation of Base Map, Final Plans and Specifications	\$20,500
Phase II:	Construction Administration	<u>\$21,000</u>
Total:		\$41,500

WHEREAS, the Borough Council finds it to be in the best interest of the Borough of Bradley Beach to authorize said work; and

WHEREAS, funding for is available by appropriation in the budget of the Borough, as evidenced by the attached certification of funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bradley Beach, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that the Mayor and Municipal Clerk are authorized to enter into a Contract with Leon S. Avakian, Inc. as described therein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause a notice to be published in the manner provided by law setting forth the nature, duration, service, and amount of the Contract and that the resolution and Contract are on file in the Office of the Clerk and are available for public inspection.
