**AUTHORIZATION TO AWARD THE SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION
PHASE II BID TO M.S.P. CONSTRUCTION, CORPORATION
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,679,173.20**

Mayor Fox offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, Kimberly M. Humphrey, QPA, Borough Administrator and Gerald J. Freda, P.E, Borough Engineer, have determined that there is a need for the acquisition of the following goods and services:

SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION – PHASE II

WHEREAS, the project will consist of clearing and preparing the site, saw cut, pavement removal, excavation, and removal of existing sanitary pipe and structures.

WHEREAS, a notice of advertisement for bids and an Invitation to Bid were prepared and advertised in accordance with the Local Public Contracts Law; and

WHEREAS, sealed bids were opened and read on Thursday, March 10, 2022 at 11:00 a.m. in accordance with the requirements of the Local Public Contracts Law; and

WHEREAS, six (6) bids were received as follows:

WHEREAS, Kimberly M. Humphrey, QPA, Borough Administrator and Gerald J. Freda, P.E, Borough Engineer, have reviewed the bids and recommend that the award of contract be made to **M.S.P. Construction, Corporation** in the amount of \$3,679,173.20 as the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Attorney, Greg Cannon has reviewed the bid proposal package of the lowest bidder, and declares them to be in conformance with the Borough's Instructions to Bidders and the Local Public Contracts Law and recommends an award of contract to M.S.P. Construction, Corporation as the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, funds are available to make such purchase or acquisition and have been certified as such by Anthony Mannino, CFO, and said certification being attached to the resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bradley Beach, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey as follows:

1. An award of contract for Drainage and Sump Pump Improvements at Monmouth Avenue and Burlington Avenue, as outlined hereinabove, is hereby made to **M.S.P. Construction, Corporation, 19 Minneakoning Road, Unit B, Flemington, N.J. 08822** in the amount of \$3,679,173.20 as the lowest responsible bidder.
2. The Mayor and Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Borough standard form of Contract for Goods and Services reference herein and made a part of this award of contract as well as any non-substantive modifications thereto and related constituent documents.
3. The Municipal Clerk is directed to forward a certified copy of this Resolution to the Qualified Purchasing Agent, Chief Financial Officer, Borough Engineer, Borough Attorney and Fernandes Construction, Inc.


