A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR EMERGENCY TEMPORARY APPROPRIATIONS FOR SEWER FUND \$100,000.00

WHEREAS, there will be a delay in the adoption of the 2022 Borough of Bradley Beach, County of Monmouth, New Jersey, Local Municipal Budget; and

WHEREAS, a temporary budget in the amount of 26.25% of the total appropriations in the 2021 budget, exclusive of any appropriations made for interest and debt redemption charges, capital improvement fund and public assistance was adopted in January 2022; and

WHEREAS, if additional funds are not budgeted, the public welfare will be adversely affected; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Acting Chief Financial Officer that this emergency temporary appropriation be authorized in the amount of \$100,000.00 for Sewer Fund in accordance with amount below; and

WHEREAS, this appropriation brings the 2022 year to date temporary appropriation for SEWER Fund to \$652,594.00. This brings the Sewer Fund temporary appropriations to 26.30% of the 2021 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Bradley Beach, County of Monmouth, New Jersey, that in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:4-20, an emergency temporary appropriation be and same is hereby made for in the amount of \$100,000.00 for Sewer Fund and that said emergency temporary appropriation shall be provided in full in the 2022 budget.
