RESOLUTION 2025-139

**RESOLUTION APPROVING ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA
FOR BRADLEY BEACH WAR MEMORIALS**

Mayor Gubitosi offered the following Resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the Borough of Bradley Beach (the “Borough”) must never forget the brave men and women who made the “ultimate sacrifice” in their service to our Country; and

WHEREAS, in order to forever preserve the memory of Bradley Beach’s own Fallen Heroes, we honor their memories by including their names on our War Memorial Monuments within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has been discussing and planning to revamp its War Memorial Monuments so that our Fallen Heroes are honored in a more cohesive and comprehensive manner;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Governing Body of the Borough of Bradley Beach hereby approves the following criteria for eligibility as a “Fallen Hero” of Bradley Beach, to be honored in memoriam on the Borough’s War Monuments:

- (1) Verifiable current or prior resident of Bradley Beach; or
- (2) Parents/guardians were verifiable residents of Bradley Beach at the time of death; and
- (3) Participated as a Bradley Beach community member over a sustained period of time; and
- (4) Served honorably in the U.S. Armed Forces, including Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard, U.S. Space Force, National Guard, or any other recognized service branch of the U.S. Armed Forces; and
- (5) Died during the qualifying dates of a war or conflict, in any location; and
- (6) Must have received the official designation as “Died in Service”, which includes Killed in Action, Missing in Action, Died of Wounds, Died of Injuries, or Died Non-Battle (e.g.: Sickness, Homicide, Suicide, Accident) in that location.
